LIQUID WASTE HAULER INFORMATIONAL SHEET

1. Any hauled liquid wastes generated outside of Monterey, Santa Cruz, or San Benito Counties must be approved by MRWPCA prior to disposal at the Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant. Requests for approval should be initiated by the liquid waste hauler via telephone or regular mail in a timely manner that allows sufficient time for MRWPCA staff to review and respond.
2. **ACCEPTABLE WASTES:** Chemical Toilet; Septage; Restaurant Grease; Biocell (dilute oily waste); Special (storm drain pumpouts; corn starch dye; wine waste; vegetable waste: artichoke & grape pulp); and Salt Brine Solutions.
3. **MANIFEST FORMS:** All manifest forms must be properly and completely filled out prior to discharge. Haulers will be turned away and not allowed to discharge for incomplete manifest forms.
4. **CHEMICAL DEODORANTS:** The chemical deodorants used in chemical toilets, which are discharged at the MRWPCA treatment plant, must be on the MRWPCA Accepted Chemical Deodorants list. A copy of the Safety Data Sheet (SDS) must be on file with MRWPCA. Use of non-approved chemical deodorants will be grounds for refusing a load for discharge.
5. **PROTECTIVE CLOTHING:** All drivers must wear safety goggles and gloves while outside of their trucks discharging liquid waste.
6. **LIQUID WASTE RECEIVING HOURS:** Current hours of operation are as follows:

Monday through Friday:	7:30am – 4:30pm	Normal Hours
	4:30pm – 10:00pm	Special Arrangement*
	10:00pm – 6:30am	Prior Authorization** or Emergency***
Saturday:	8:00am – 4:00pm	Normal Hours
	4:00pm – 8:00am	Prior Authorization** or Emergency***
Sunday:	Closed;	Prior Authorization** or Emergency***
- * Special Arrangement: A special arrangement is required if you are going to discharge between the hours of 4:30pm and 10:00pm Monday through Friday. We request that you give as much advance notice as possible if you have a project or job that is going to require the disposal of wastes during these hours.
- ** Prior Authorization: Prior authorization is required for all "other" hours. Prior authorization entails requesting, in writing, advanced approval for upcoming special projects or events taking place in Monterey County which, due to special circumstances, require you to discharge during these hours.
- *** Emergency: For situations in which you are required to respond to an emergency incident. We request that you call the Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant Control Room at (831) 883-6166 as soon as possible and explain the circumstances of the emergency, and the need to dispose during these "other" hours. MRWPCA can then make the necessary arrangements for personnel coverage to handle your discharge.
7. **MRWPCA PERMIT REQUIREMENTS:**
 - a) **INSURANCE:** At policy renewal, and upon changing insurance companies, all haulers must provide to MRWPCA a Certificate of Insurance for the following:
 - i. Automobile Insurance: List MRWPCA, 5 Harris Court, Bldg. D, Monterey, CA 93940 as Additional Insured with your insurance company. Coverage needs to be maintained at a minimum of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and combined single limit coverage for bodily injury and property damage.
 - ii. Workers Compensation Insurance: Coverage needs to be maintained at \$1,000,000 or higher level per accident for bodily injury or disease.
 - iii. General Liability Insurance: coverage needs to be maintained at \$1,000,000 or higher level per occurrence for bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage.
 - b) **SOLID WASTE PERMIT:** Every year, your liquid waste trucks must be inspected and you must obtain a Solid Waste Management Services permit from the Monterey County Health Department Division of Environmental Health. Annually you must provide to MRWPCA a copy of your Non-Hazardous Liquid Waste Vehicle Inspection Form.
8. **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION and REQUIREMENTS:** are contained in the MRWPCA Liquid Waste Hauler Discharge Permit and MRWPCA Wastewater Discharge Ordinance No. 2008-01 and MRWPCA Liquid Waste Ordinance No. 2015-01.
