

NO DRUGS DOWN THE DRAIN



Safely dispose pharmaceutical wastes:

1. **Ask your pharmacy to take them back.**
2. **Go to a pharmacy with a take-back program** (see list on back).

OR

3. **Follow the White House Drug Policy for disposing medical wastes in the trash:** Remove the medicines from the original container and mix them with an unpleasant waste material, such as used kitty litter, ashes or coffee grounds. Then place the mixture in an impermeable container such as a sealable bag before discarding in the trash.
