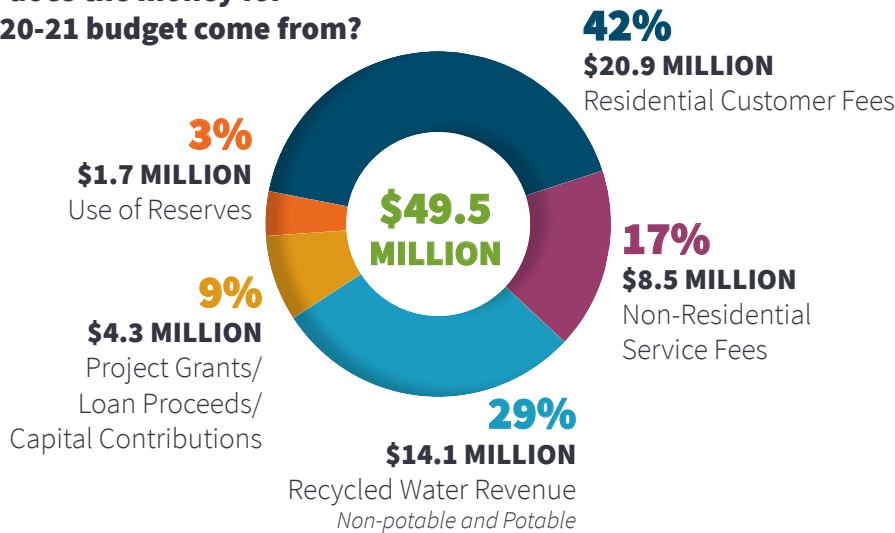

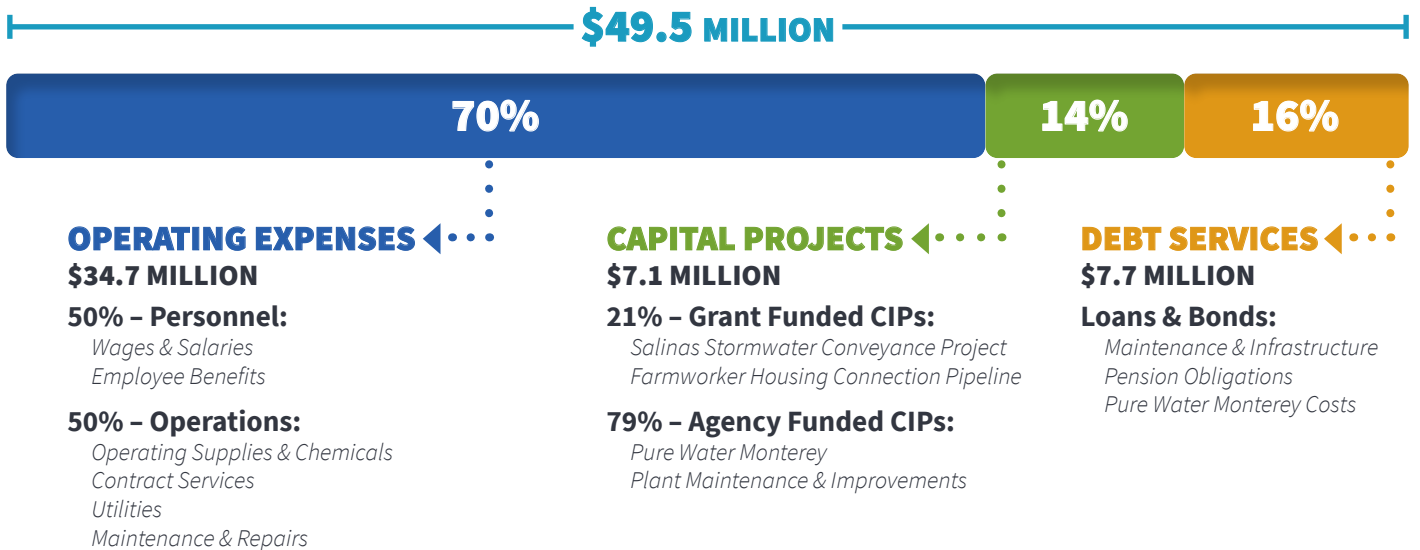

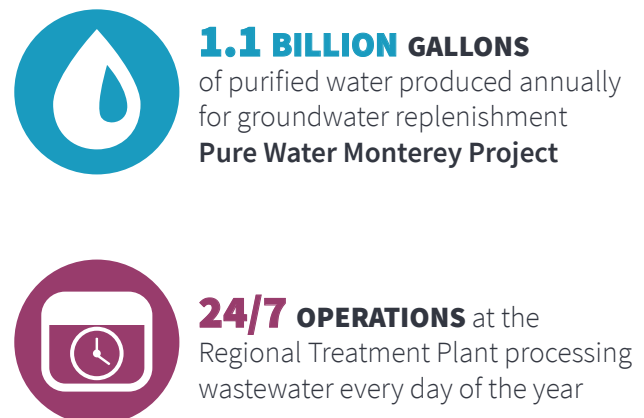
USES OF FUNDS
